The Lakeside Community Planning Group Trails Sub Committee met to discuss the three new trails proposed by Diane Jacob.

- 1. Trail to connect Blossom Valley/ Flynn Springs/ Crest Ridge.
- 2. County to purchase and make the "Flume" in Lakeside a trail for hiking/equestrians.
- 3. Trail on the North East side of Moreno Ave up to the new development in Muth Valley. (Property is owned by SDG&E, and there is already a utility road from the building of the Power Link)

These meetings are open to the public and anyone is allowed to attend.

Lakeside Equestrian Center will begin accepting donations within a few months. The 501c3 has been applied for. And we are looking forward to starting the different phases of this project.

The park is extending the boundaries of cultural and biological protected areas near Los Vaqueros group camp and may possibly threaten access to trail. CSP implied that existing trails would remain.
