Los Vaqueros Horse Camp:

CRSPIA Meeting: Joyce Jewell and Billie-Jo Swanson attended July's CRSPIA (Cuyamaca Rancho State Park Interpretive Association) meeting. Joyce announced that CRSPIA installed new swivel showerheads, replacing the stationary ones, at Los Vaqueros Horse Camp, so now they won't spray all over the middle of the shower room and get our clothes wet.

All Clubs Beach Ride: Members inquired about the annual All Clubs Beach Ride because there has not been a flyer sent out yet. The date is set for August 26th. Bonita Valley Horsemen will host the event and traditionally provide hotdogs and ask that anyone attending provide a side dish for the potluck-style lunch after the ride. As we get more information, we will let everyone know the details.



Next Year's Events: Barbara asked members about what they would like to see during this next year for activities, such as different areas for club rides and where? No suggestions were offered.

Barbara asked for Poker Ride Fundraiser suggestions/ideas. It will not be until March or April next year, hopefully in the river bottom, but we are looking for other location suggestions/ideas.



Billie-Jo suggested using Rancho Penasquitos with staging over by the school for the poker ride and also make it a trail challenge with all the bikes, and hikers. We will need to talk to the ranger.

Marge suggested Windfall Ranch. There was a lot of positive response to that idea, but there were concerns that it is too far for our "locals" who usually attend our ride. Joyce did share that LFR did hold the poker ride at Windfall Ranch, about 11 years ago, with cloudy weather, only earning \$300.00 in the past.



Kammi suggested utilizing the trails in the river bottom more on the west side and up on the hill for the poker ride route, closer to River Valley Equestrian Center (old Hering Ranch). Marge and Theresa will consider those ideas for mapping the ride. We will call Tumbleweed to check on the availability for dates in Mar/April.

Barbara asked for ideas regarding clinics. Jeanne A. suggested having a mountain bike/equestrian clinic and she is approaching Calvary Ranch about hosting this clinic.

TRAILS REPORTS:

Barbara asked if anyone has anything to report regarding trails. It was reported that the land owned by Helix Water District in the El Monte Valley was sold to the "sand miners." Even though the El Monte Valley land was bought, the EIR still has to come out, with 45 days for public comment, approval of the use permits, and then come before the Board of Supervisors. Public input and public attendance when El Monte Valley comes before the Board of Supervisors is needed.

Sand mining was approved and will start on Moreno Ave, across from Billi-Jo's property.
