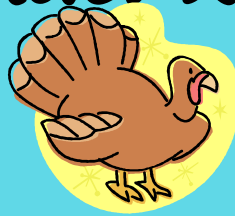

Brag:

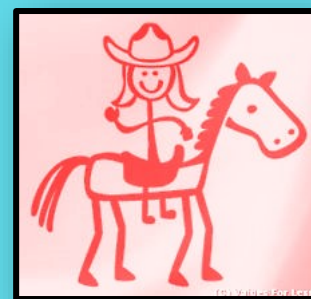
Steve and Cyndi sold their LQ trailer!!! Waiting for their new one to arrive.

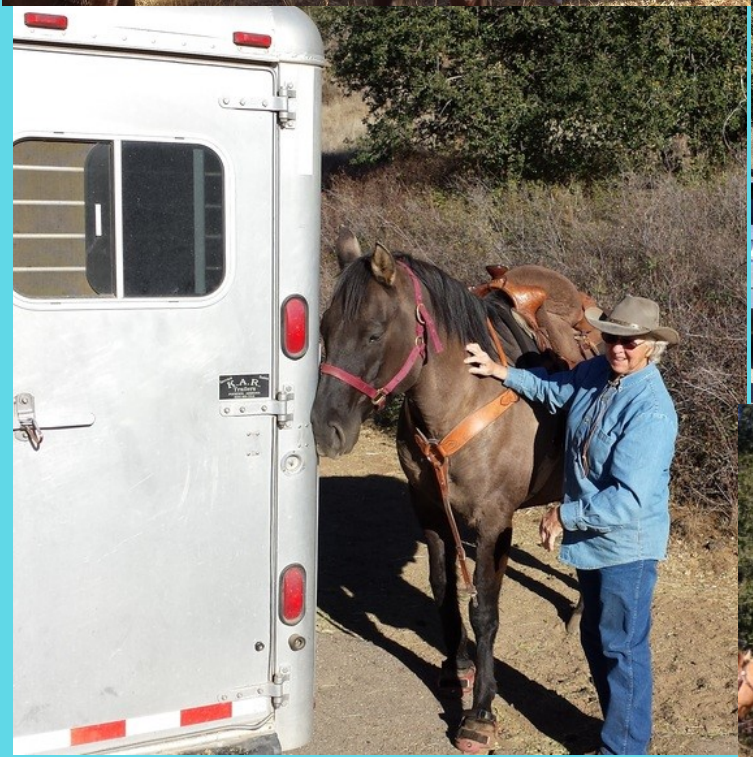
