Moreno Ave (SDGE) to Muth Valley trail is classified as an endangered habitat and is no longer "trail friendly".

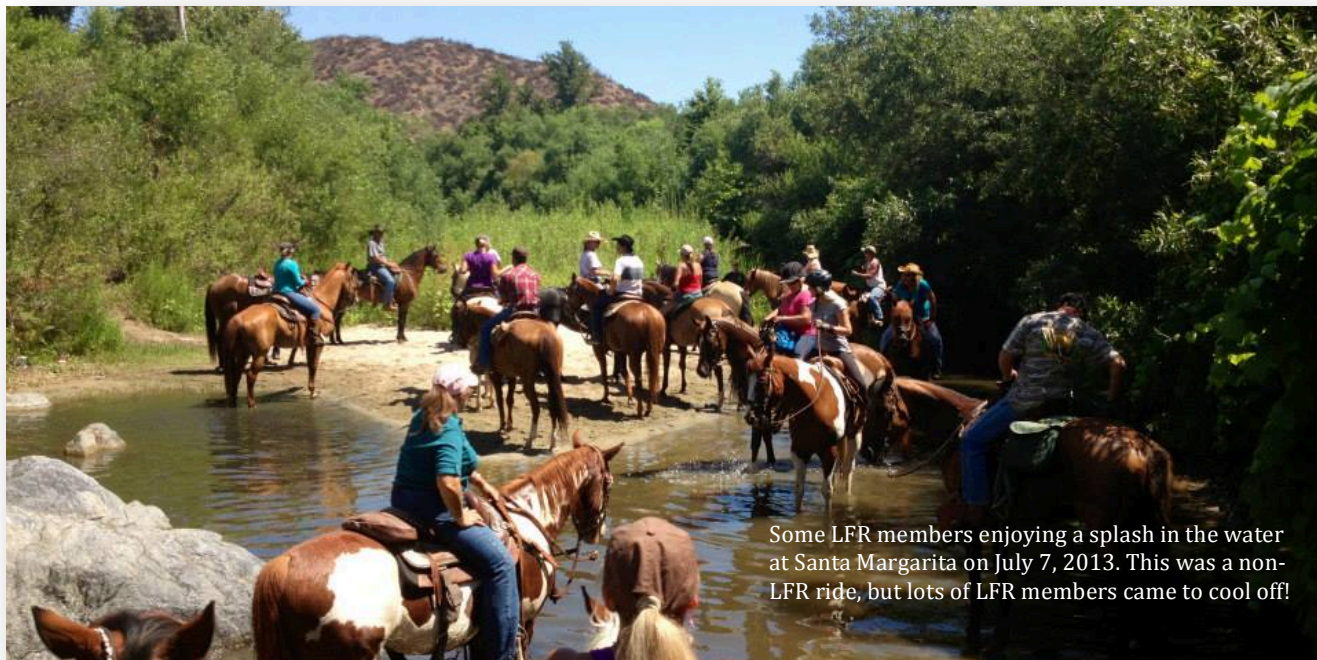
