

LFR Rules for Camping

General Rules:

- 1) Remove ALL manure. This includes all areas, including: tie racks, corrals, black top road, parking lot, or anywhere else in the immediate camp area.
- 2) Remove ALL hay, shavings, food, and manure from corrals and double check right before when leaving and pulling away in your truck/trailer.
- 3) Do NOT dump your water bucket in corrals. Dump it in the dirt or on the blacktop so it will roll away from the corrals.
- 4) All dogs must be on a leash.
- 5) All dog poop must be picked up, and watch the male dogs so they do not pee on anyone's personal property, tack, hay, etc.
- 6) Please arrive and depart at designated times (for Los Vaqueros, arrive 2:30 p.m. / check out at 12:00 p.m.)
- 7) Monies paid for camp are NON-REFUNDABLE. It is the same amount if you are there for only one night or all nights.
- 8) You may split your corral fee with someone else by splitting the days, (for example: you have it Thurs/Fri night and leave Saturday morning; now your corral buddy arrives on Saturday afternoon and has the corral for the nights of Saturday/Sunday/Monday; therefore, you split the one corral fee amount). Please work out the details between you and your corral buddy, and then please inform the camp coordinator of the two names and days you are splitting.
9. If a member would like to join us and camp at Los Vaqueros without a horse and you are using a trailer or tent, there is a \$10 a night fee.
10. Generators may be started at 8:00 a.m., and must be shut off by 9:00 p.m. Minimal use of generators is requested due to the noise.

Rules Regarding Visitors:

- 1) Because of insurance coverage purposes, no one is allowed to come into camp and camp overnight and/or RIDE unless they are a current LFR Member.
- 2) LFR members are welcome come to camp for a day ride and stay for potluck, just pay the \$10 per day fee to our camp coordinator or treasurer when you arrive at camp.
- 3) If a non-member would like to ride with a member, for Los Vaqueros they must stage at Sweetwater Bridge, GVF, or old Boy Scout Camp and ride over. It is fine if they ride into camp to meet you.
- 4) Family members are welcome to come up and visit during the day and join in our potluck even if you have a single membership. If they are spending the night, you will then need to have a family membership and can just "upgrade" by paying the \$5 difference to our camp coordinator or treasurer at that time.

Sometimes circumstances may make an exception to these rules. If you have any questions, please ask.

If the camp coordinator, officers, or directors ask questions or speak to you regarding camp rules, it is only for the protection of our club and our members. Please understand that we are not trying to be rude, bossy, or singling you out, but it is our responsibility to protect our club by following the rules and to ensure the club is welcomed back to camp in the future.

Please remember to observe the official camp rules established by each national, state, or county park, and private camps, such as Stagecoach, Butterfield, etc.
